Due to non-forwarding of Diploma in Pharmacy Certificate, Ms. Meha was held ineligible in Initial Ineligible and Eligible List posted on 07.12.2023 as per the scrutiny report provided by User Department and given ten days time to submit representation, if any. Thereafter, Ms. Meha had represented on 15.12.2023 and submitted proof of acquiring Diploma in Pharmacy before crucial cut-off date i.e. 27.03.2023. On the basis of the representation, User Department has re-scrutinized all her documents and found that as per her Registration Certificate of Ayurvedic Up-Vaid, the candidate can dispense medicines only in the State of Punjab. Accordingly, User Department has now made her ineligible with a new remark which was not mentioned in the Initial Ineligible and Eligible List posted on 07.12.2023. Therefore, Ms. Neha is hereby informed that she is now held ineligible for the post of Pharmacist (Ayurvedic) as the Registration Certificate submitted by her states that "she is eligible to dispense medicine in the State of Punjab only". Representations received late will not be entertained under any circumstances. Communication other than e-mail will not be considered.
